Other scores etc. that Mum thought you might be interested in, I set the Victorian state subbies' (Under 10) trick record 6 times with the best on the mile in 1992, 2470. The last two of these performances (2390 and 2470) were Australian records as well. I was on the Victorian team 10 times, Australian Junior Worlds reserve (1998), Asian Australasian team once (2004), Aussie Kiwi Team 6 times and reserve once (1994 reserve, team 1996, 1997, 1999, 2001 2002 and 2005). University national team for Worlds twice (2002 and 2004). Won about 10 nationals across events, 4 years running university national jump champion, I think 12 university national championships. Don't know how many state championships but lots. Held the SA open men's jump record for 5 years. And made \$1000 going over the jump at moon and dressed as a giant kookaburra.

I moved to Adelaide in 2000, I think I skied the 2000 nationals as Victorian and the 2001 as SA, but not sure about when I was last a member of Geelong.
