



# GEELONG WATERSKI CLUB EVENT GUIDELINES

## VICTORIAN INTER-CLUB CHALLENGE

### 1. General

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## 2. Content

### A. Entry Requirements

- (1) Skiers in the tournament must be members of the AWWF. Those who are not current members may be able to make use of AWWF temporary membership for this tournament. There will be application forms available at the Geelong Club House.
- (2) Only the first 60 entries off the bank per day will be accepted.
- (3) Skiers may enter as Club Teams or Independents
- (4) Team Entry
  - (a) Only Bona Fide Victorian clubs may enter Teams. Check with Ian Chiron or Trevor Pratt to confirm your Club is on the list of current Victorian Clubs.
  - (b) Each club may nominate 6 slalom skiers, 6 trick skiers and 6 jumpers plus up to 10 subs. They don't have to be the same people, so the team could have up to 18 (plus subs) skiers. It could have as few as 3.
  - (c) Skiers not in Club Teams may enter as Independents
- (5) Independent Entry
  - (a) Independents do not receive place points
- (6) Scoring
  - (a) Scoring will be in accordance with the AWWF rules.
  - (b) The competition will be run in ability divisions as per the VWSF rules
  - (c) Divisions will command 10 points per event per round for the winner. The top 3 in each event will count towards the team score.
  - (d) Mini Course
    - 1) The skiers must go through the gates and around the Mini course buoys until they miss a buoy or a gate
    - 2) The skier may nominate the speed; it stays the same for each pass.

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- 3) The Skier will have 4 passes
  - 4) The skier scores one point for going just outside the Mini buoy, 5 points for going half way to the main course buoy and 10 points if he goes around the main course buoy. I.e. the further out the skier goes the more points he will get
  - 5) The skier can score 6 points for going just outside 6 Mini buoys and up to a maximum of 60 points per pass if he goes around all the main buoys.
  - 6) Selection of Mini Course must be made at time of application
  - 7) The Mini course will count in the Inter Club competition.
  - 8) There is no age limit on mini course
- (7) Results
- (a) The winner of the tournament will be awarded the *Klipspringer* Perpetual Trophy

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
